

WHAT IS THE EDTPA?

The edTPA is a performance-based test that is nationally used to assess skills such as planning, instruction and assessment, in future educators. With a focus on student learning and principles from research and theory, the edTPA is designed to engage teacher candidates to authentically demonstrate their understanding of teaching and student learning. Candidates will be required to complete tasks and commentaries within a portfolio relevant to their program as evidence of planned and implemented instruction.
